

# Notice of Race The Leukemia Cup Regatta *A fundraising event* June 27, 28 & 29, 2014

The Northern Ohio Leukemia & Lymphoma Society is the Organizing Authority for this *fundraising* regatta and The Cleveland Yachting Club is the Host Club and will provide race management.

# Conditions

#### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2013-2016 International Sailing Federation (ISAF), the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of participating classes; except as any of these changed by this Notice of Race and/or the Sailing Instructions and any amendments hereafter. The regatta is subject to the Advertising restrictions as defined in RRS Appendix 1 (Advertising.) Those classes satisfying Regulation 20 qualifications for Category C are urged to refrain from displaying advertisements for businesses or products competing with those of the primary and support sponsors of the event.

# 2. Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to all members of US SAILING, other National Governing Body, members of recognized yacht clubs, or members of recognized sailing associations.

<u>Women's Division</u>: A Race will be offered for women meeting the requirements of the Cleveland Sailing Association's (CSA) Women's Division. (<u>www.clevelandsails.com</u>) This race will be offered Friday, June 27, 2014 only.

<u>Double Handed Division</u>: A Race will be offered for boats meeting the requirements of the Cleveland Sailing Association's (CSA) Double Handed Division. (www.clevelandsails.com). This race will be offered Friday, June 27, 2014 only.

<u>Cruising Classes</u>: Races will be offered for the Cruising Class Division. The Race Committee Chairman, at its sole discretion, whose decision is final and without appeal, shall determine eligibility and placement within divisions for the cruising class

<u>PHRF and JAM Classes</u>: Races will be offered for PHRF and JAM rated boats. The Race Committee Chairman, at its sole discretion, whose decision is final and without appeal, shall determine eligibility and placement within divisions for the PHRF and JAM classes.

<u>One Design</u>: Races will be offered for T-10, J-22, J-105, J-70, Beneteau 36.7, Star and R Boats. Separate starts may be scheduled for One Design boats with 5 or more pre-registered (by June 16, 2014) and paid entries and who are member of a nationally recognized Class.

Lake Erie PHRF ratings shall be used to determine handicaps for PHRF and JAM classes. (PHRF certificate is preferred but not necessary.)

#### 3. Entries

Classes shall meet eligibility requirements no later than June 26, 2014.

Completed entry forms, with the entry fee, shall be mailed (postmarked by Monday June 16, 2014). Checks payable to: Leukemia Cup Regatta (Registration after June 16 will incur a \$25 late fee.)

# 4. Registration

All registrations need to be in by June 16, 2014.

Any registrations received after June 16<sup>th</sup> will be subject to a \$25 late fee. Each boat owner or a representative must report to Cleveland Yachting Club at Center Isle, between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM on Friday, June 27, 2014, to pick up their race packet.

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be posted at Cleveland Yachting Club, by 8:30 AM daily, and it is the responsibility of each competitor to check the Official Notice Board (located at Center Isle) for any amendments or other notices. Scratch Sheet will be available on Saturday, June 28, starting at 8:00 AM at Center Isle.

#### 5. Racing Area

There will be two racing areas approximately one to three miles north and northeast of the Rocky River main entrance on Lake Erie. Class assignments and course locations will be included with the sailing instructions.

#### 6. Schedule of Races

There will be a Women's Division race scheduled for Friday, June 27, 2014. The warning signal for this race is scheduled for 6:30 PM.

There will be a Double Handed Division race scheduled for Friday, June 27, 2014. The warning signal for this race is scheduled for 6:30 PM.

The first warning is scheduled for 9:55 AM on each day of racing. It is the intent of the Organizing Authority and the Race Committee to run as many races as practical on Saturday, June 28, 2014, through Sunday, June 29, 2014, up to a maximum of 7. No Warning Signal will be made after 2:30 PM on Sunday, June 28, 2014.

#### 7. Measurement

The Organizing Authority or the Cleveland Yachting Club does not require measurement, but each boat shall submit proof of holding a valid measurement certificate at registration if required by the class. One Design National Class Rules and crew weight apply for competition.

Cruising Class entrants must submit a valid 2013 PHRF-LE rating certificate by the registration deadline. Boats without a current PHRF-LE certificate may be assigned a temporary rating at the discretion of the Race Committee Chairman that shall be valid for this regatta only.

# 8. Scoring

The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A4 will apply, except that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. One race will constitute a series. This changes RRS Appendix A.

# 9. Courtesy broadcasts

The Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on a designated courtesy channel. Information so provided will not be subject to action under RRS 62.

# 10. Prizes

Top fundraising boats will be recognized at the end of the racing event as well as at the Fall Auction. Prizes will be awarded for Top 3 class finishers

# 11. Guest Dockage & Launching

Yachts arriving by water will be given complimentary guest dockage starting on Monday afternoon, June 23. Guest dockage will be available after the event up until Monday afternoon June 30, 2014. Upon arrival please hail the CYC Gas Dock on Marine CH 9 for dockage or rafting instructions. For those arriving by land, there is crane launching available; Skipper must schedule launch & haul prior to June 16, 2014 with CYC Harbor Master. \**Please call the Administration Team if special dockage is needed*.
