Notice of Race

Cape to Cape Challenge VI Friday and Saturday, August 1-2, 2014

The Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May (CYCCM) together with Lewes Yacht Club (LYC) is proud to invite all offshore sailors to compete in the annual Lewes to Cape May Race for the annual "Cape to Cape" Challenge Cup. The organizing authorities are CYCCM and LYC.

- 1. **Rules**. The race will be governed by the current rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, prescriptions of US Sailing and PHRF-MA, and the Sailing Instructions. If a PHRF Certificate is not provided, the appropriate PHRF-MA rating will be assigned by the Race Committee. An entry must select the proper Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker class and sail all races in the same class.
- 2. **Notice to Competitors.** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the Corinthian Yacht Club and Lewes Yacht Club.
- 3. **Sailing Instructions.** Sailing Instructions will be provided to all competitors at the Skipper's meetings. Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted as soon as practical.

4. Schedule of Races.

3 races are scheduled: Two Round-the-buoys races on Friday August 1, 2014 at Lewes and one distance race on Saturday August 2, 2014 from Lewes to Cape May.

5. Racing Area.

Refer to the course maps in the Sailing Instructions for both day's courses. Day 1: The racing area will be the Delaware Bay near the Roosevelt Inlet. The starting area will about ½ mile north of the Roosevelt Inlet.

- Day 2: The racing area will be the Delaware Bay and Atlantic Ocean. The course will be announced at the Skipper's meeting. The start will be about ½ mile north of the Roosevelt Inlet and proceed on the announced course to the finish near Cape May.
- 6. **The Course.** The Saturday course will be announced at the Skipper's meeting Friday night. Refer to the sailing instructions for the Friday courses.
- 7. **The Start.** There will be a separate start for each class, spinnaker then non-spinnaker.
- 8. **Scoring**. The Low Point Scoring Systems, RRS A4 shall apply. All races sailed count for the Cape to Cape Cup and there is no throw out. Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes shall be scored separately using the scoring weights below:
 - Round-the-Buoys Race 1 − 25%
 - Round-the-Buoys Race 2 25%
 - C2C Distance Race 50%
- 9. **Prizes**. Regatta prizes will be awarded as follows:

Appendix 2: Dockage and Lodging

CAPE MAY: Dockage will be available at the CYCCM floating docks for draft up to 5 feet. Alternative dock space is available at Utschs, South Jersey Marina, and Cape May Marine for deep draft vessels. The CYCCM docks have limited power and facilities (bathroom/shower). Some lodging is available upon request. Please send requests to fleetcaptain@cyccm.com.

LEWES: The Lewes Canal front Park Marina Dockmaster will monitor channel 16 until 1700. Dock space has been reserved for all Cape-Cape registered vessels in the center of Lewes at 2 locations:

- 1. The Lewes Canal Front Park Marina (5 slips) where the showers and heads are located just past the Red Overfalls Lightship on the right. MLW of about 6 feet.
- 2. The 200' City Dock (up to 12 boats) 200 yards further on the right and adjacent to the Draw Bridge. This space will allow 2 boat raft ups. MLW is about 10 feet.
- 30 and 50 amp power and water available at both locations.
- Transportation to and from LYC on Thursday and Friday from 1600 to 2200 provided by 16-passenger mini van leaving the City Dock and Canal Park Marina every half hour.
- LYC offers their amenities to visiting sailors, including our swimming pool and snack bar. Showers and heads also available at the pool.
