AMENDMENT 1

Add section to Paragraph 9 Starting:

9.7 Prior to the start, each boat shall come by the stern of the Race Committee boat to check in by stating their boat name and sail number.

AMENDMENT 2

Delete published section 17 Scoring and replace it with the following:

17 SCORING

- 17.1 Each division will be scored using current PHRF handicaps provided by YRALIS. "Spinnaker W/L Ratings" will be used for Spinnaker Classes and "No-Spinnaker W/L Ratings" will be used for Non-Spinnaker Classes. Boats without a valid YRA of LIS certificate will be assigned the base rating for their boat.
- 17.2 Weight limits will not be in effect, except that any boat sailing with a "light crew" rating shall sail as rated.
- 17.3 Scoring will be done using Time-on-Distance computation. The distance of each race shall be determined by the Race Committee, and will not be grounds for redress-
- 17.4 Series scoring will be calculated using the Cox-Sprague System, with the points for each race determined by the number of starters in the Class and the finishing position of each yacht (see Appendix A for details).
- 17.5 Participation in eight of the scheduled races is needed to qualify for a trophy. Yachts serving as Race Committee, starting a race that is subsequently cancelled, or in the Starting Area during a postponement prior to a cancellation, shall receive credit towards qualifying should the yacht not otherwise complete the required eight races.
- 17.6 If a yacht sails in more races than needed to qualify, its season standing shall be determined by scoring of the yacht's best eight races.

APENDIX A

Cox-Sprague Scoring System

Cox-Sprague scoring system recommended by Y.R.A. of L.I.S, modified as described below will be used.

In each race the number of starters will determine the column to be used in the table below, and each boat will be credited with the number of points indicated for her finishing place. A boat's series score shall be her "Percentage of Perfection" calculated by dividing her total points scored by the total points she would have had, had she won every race in which she started. A boat which does not finish or is disqualified in a race shall receive a score for the place one greater than the number of starters in that race using the next column in the table to determine the number of points.
