Wednesday Night Light & COVID - 19 Procedures

June 10th - July 1st we will be racing a Wednesday Night Light ("WNL").

The regatta series as well as the crew limitations will be dependent on the state restrictions for social distancing. The current state of CT protocol is a maximum of 5 people may be in one group. BRYC/FYC will follow the general guidelines and social protocol outlined by the YRALIS and US Sailing for running regattas. As it may be difficult to put a full crew together, we will be holding non scored races to July 1st. From June 10th to July 1st we would run a series of races, that would not count towards the overall season. July 8th, we would start the official WNR series, with all races from July 8th to September 9th recorded.

July 8th we will start the Wednesday Night Series ("WNS"). The WNS will be a 9-week series.

Below are the "suggested" protocols from US Sailing and YRALIS.

 - o rush hour arrival protocols
 - o maintaining distance on ramp and dock
 - o limit shared gear/clothing
 - o masks on launch yes
 - o masks onboard Skippers responsibility
- Race Committee modifications
 - o limit # aboard the Donahue to 2
 - o ollie no flags See amendment "U
 - o use of chase boat
 - o Protests will not be allowed on a formal basis during the WNL series.
