## Notice of Race.

- 1. Rules. The race will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 ("RRS") and the General Conditions and Rules of the Eastern Long Island Sailing Association ("ELIYA"), except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- **2.** Eligibility. This event is open to all sailing boats that have a 2020 ELIYA issued PHRF certificate. Participants can attain a PHRF Certificate from ELIYA @ <a href="https://phrfeli.org/">https://phrfeli.org/</a>
- **3.** Entry. Will be through Yacht Scoring. https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=13058
- **4. Fees.** The entry fee is \$70 per boat.

- **6.** Sailing Instructions. The sailing instructions will be available on the club website, on Yacht Scoring and posted online by Aug 15, 2020
- 7. <u>Venue.</u> The Race will be held in the waters around Gardiner's Island.

- **8.** Skippers Meeting. A decision on the venue and form of the Skipper's Meeting will be decided as the season progresses, and will be decided by August 15,2020
- **9.** Course. The Course will be either clockwise or counterclockwise, to be announced the day of the Race.
- **10.** <u>Scratch Sheets</u>. Scratch sheets will be available online on Yacht Scoring and the DYC website after 1730 on Friday, August 28, 2020
- **11. Scoring.** The Time on Time handicap system will be used to score the individual placement of participants completing the Race.
- **12.** <u>Time Limit.</u> If no participant has finished the Race by 1730 hours, it will be considered No Race.
- 13. <u>Communications</u>. The Committee Boat will broadcast on and monitor VHF channel 11 If a yacht decides to retire it is necessary for the yacht to notify the Committee Boat via VHF or to call the club and leave word with the club manager. (631-267-6340)
- **11.** <u>Alternative Penalties.</u> The Two-Turns Penalty rule will apply in accordance with RRS Part 4, Rule 44.1
- **12. Protest.** Due to the pandemic, protest protocols are being reviewed and an announcement regarding 2020 procedures will be included in the SI
- **13.** <u>Dockage</u>. There will be no dockage offered this year. Decision on availability of moorings will be made by August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- **14.** <u>Trophies</u>. Trophies will be awarded to the top three yachts in each division for this race. Trophies will be awarded for any One Design class with four or more entries.
- 15. Media Waiver. Competitors and crew members on the competing yachts grant, at no cost, the Devon Yacht Club, and any other official sponsors of the regatta, the absolute right and permission to use their name, voice, image, likeness, biographical material as well as representations of the boats in any media worldwide (being television, print and internet media), including video footage, for the sole purposes of advertising, promoting, reporting and disseminating information regarding the 'Round Gardiner's Island Race at the 'Round Gardiner's Island Race Weekend and the participants in the 'Round Gardiner's Island Race Weekend Events.
