4. Location of first start

Generally, the first start of each racing day will be in Simpson Bay. This may be changed by notifying entered competitors by email the day before any racing day.

5. Courses

Courses to be sailed will be announced by VHF

prior to the first warning signal of each start sequence.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 Scoring will be by the low point system.
- 6.2 An entrant not competing in any of the races will be scored with number of registered entries plus one.
- 6.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7. prizes

7.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class over the Keelboat Series.7.2 Daily awards will be awarded.
