

The Essex Rum Challenge Saturday July 24, 2021

Organizing Authority (OA): Essex YC Notice of Race



Including Amendments

Rules The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Essex Yacht Club

strongly recommends that entrants comply with the US Safety Equipment Requirements for

Nearshore Races available at www.ussailing.org or at www.yachtscoring.com.

Eligibility The regatta is open to all boats with a valid 2021 ECSA PHRF or NEMA Rating Certificate.

Classes There will be spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes. Double-handed and multi-hull classes will be

offered if there are sufficient entries.

Entries <u>must</u> be made on the event website at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>. Entries must be

received by 1200, Friday July 23, 2021. The entry fee is \$40 per yacht (\$35 if member of USSA), however, **entries before July 1**st, **2021 will be \$30.** Late entries (after July 21, 2021)

shall be subject to a late entry fee of \$20.

Clubs are encouraged to enter at least three boats to better compete for the Rum Challenge Club

Trophy.

PHRF entrants must have a 2021 ECSA PHRF certificate posted on the ECSA website at www.ecsa.net/PHRF/PHRFLookup. On request, the OA will assign a PHRF rating for this regatta for any entries from outside the ECSA area who provide a current rating certificate from their regional PHRF authority. Multi-hull entries must have a valid NEMA certificate on the

NEMA website at www.nemasail.org.

Schedule The First Warning will be at 1200 hours. The Race Committee may decide to sail two races.

Courses The starting area will be approximately ¼ mile west of the Old Saybrook Outer Light. Courses

will be windward-leeward with drop marks, point-to-point around government marks or a

combination of both based on weather and tide conditions.

https://www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=14484 and at the Skipper's Meeting held at Essex Yacht Club 1800 Friday July 23, 2021. For those unable to attend the Skippers Meeting in-person, the meeting will also be available via Zoom (link to follow). The skipper's package, including Goslings' hats, party tickets, and the program will be available at the Skipper's

Meeting and at the awards party. Race documents will not be distributed on the water

Scoring Boats will be scored using PHRF Time on Time handicaps. Each boat's score for the regatta

shall be the combined total of her race scores. This is an ECSA Regatta and is one of a five race

series necessary to qualify for the Long Sand Shoal Cup.

Risk Statement The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers

alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of

injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death

by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

Prizes Individual prizes will be awarded to the top-placed boats in each class

The **Essex Rum Challenge Club Trophy** will be awarded to the yacht club with the best combined class scores of any three yachts using the ECSA Offshore Circuit Scoring System

Matrix.

Awards Party Prizes will be awarded at the awards party at Essex Yacht Club following the races. Party tickets

are \$15 per person at entry or \$25 per person at the door. Essex Yacht Club will follow State

current guidelines regarding outdoor gatherings.
