- **6.2** Nine (9) races are scheduled with 3 races per day. If, in the opinion of the race committee, the regatta is behind schedule or likely to fall behind schedule, up to 4 races may be raced on one day.
- 6.3 Daily Awards will be presented directly following racing each day at the social events on the Great Harbor Yacht Club lawn. Overall awards will be presented at the closing social event on Sunday, June 19 directly following racing.
- 6.4 Social Events will begin daily immediately following racing at approximately 1630. Weekend Regatta Social Package tickets <u>may be purchased here</u> for visiting family and friends. Regatta Charging Privileges are also available for teams looking to charge any food or drinks over the weekend. <u>Full details and form can be found here.</u>

SI 10, MARKS, is deleted and replaced with:

- **10.1** The original weather mark will be an inflatable orange tetrahedron. The leeward gate marks will yellow inflatable tetrahedrons.
- 10.2 The weather mark will have an associated offset mark which will be an orange inflatable tetrahedron.
- **10.3** The starting and finishing marks will be an orange tetrahedron and RC vessels.
- **10.4** Any change marks will be green inflatable tetrahedrons.
- 10.5 If a leeward mark is missing or out of place, boats shall round the remaining mark to port.
