Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2021-2024*, except as modified by the regatta Sailing Instructions. Updates /revisions will be posted on this website and on the Yacht Scoring Official Notice Board.

Entry Due: Friday, May 27, 2022 - Late Fee (additional \$25) applies after May 27th
Early Bird Entry discount deadline - April 30th
(Early Bird Entries also receive 10 free regatta drink tickets)

Entry Fee: PHRF & ONE DESIGN FLEETS (Fri/Sat/Sun):
Early Bird = \$155. Entries after April 30th = \$170.
CRUISING FLEETS (SBRW Cruising Fleet & ORC Cruiser), ORC DOUBLE HANDED (DH), and MULTIHULL (CMA): (Sat/Sun only):

Early Bird = \$ 84. Entries after April 30th = \$ 99.

OLD POINT BANK LOYALTY DISCOUNT:
ALL 2021 SBRW returnees may deduct \$25 from above entry fees.

NOTE: ORC DH, MULTIHULL (CMA), and One Design classes must have at least four (4) boats entered and paid by May 9th.

LATE FEE: Additional \$25 for entries received after Friday, May 27th

Eligibility: All boats must be at least 20 feet LOA. Classes expected include PHRF Super A, A, B, C, NS (double headsail allowed) and SBRW Cruising (one headsail only) plus ORC Cruiser, ORC DH, MULTIHULL (CMA), and One-Design classes with 4 or more entries.

All boats must meet the Nearshore category of the US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (which are posted at the HYC website), except One-Design class boats which must meet their class safety standards. Boats may not be sailed single-handed.

Each fleet must have an applicable valid 2022 rating certificate:

- * PHRF = PHRF of the Chesapeake
- *ORC Cruiser = ORC Club
- *ORC Double Handed = ORC DH
- *Multihull = Chesapeake Multihull Association (CMA)
- *SBRW Cruising = as assigned by SBRW Race Committee

NO FLEET CHANGES may be made after 1800, THURSDAY, JUNE 2nd.

ORC DH, MULTIHULL (CMA), and One Design classes must have at least four (4) boats entered and paid by May 9th.

PHRF and ONE-DESIGN FLEETS

- Three days of racing...four nights of parties...all for the same low price
- All racing in the Harbor on two circles
- Fleets divided between both circles to provide close, competitive racing
- Program:
 - ✚ Multiple windward/leeward races daily on both circles
 - ✚ 10 - 12 head knockin', gear bustin' race series intended (3-4 races daily)
 - ✚ Experienced race committees to keep things square, fair, and moving
 - ✚ Multiple weather marks and gates to ensure great racing

CRUISING FLEETS - SBRW Cruising, ORC Cruiser, ORC DH, and Multihull

- Two days of racing...four nights of parties...for a reduced entry fee
- All racing in the Bay off Buckroe / Salt Ponds
- Experienced race committee
- Fleets sub-divided as appropriate for good, fun racing
- Program:
 - ✚ Open-course, random leg races using government marks (no windward/leewards)
 - ✚ Saturday = Two races of approximately 1½ hours each
 - ✚ Sunday = One race of approximately 2½ hours
 - ✚ Appropriate course lengths for diverse fleets
