1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

1.1 Breakwater Yacht Club

2. RULES - Racing will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Sag Harbor Cup is open to all sailboats with a valid 2022 PHRF/ELI Certificate. **Division 4 (J-70's) do not need a PHRF/ELI Certificate and will be assigned a rating by the RC.**

3.2 To get a PHRF/ELI Certificate, go to www.elisailing.org and follow the links on the right hand column.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 Saturday **September 10th**, 2022

1300 hrs. First Sound Signal

Deck Party and BBQ to follow at BYC

5. ENTRY FEES – Due by 5pm on Thursday, **September 8th**, 2022.

5.1 \$50.00 entry fee covers boat entry and a Sag Harbor Cup hat. All registration and payment needs to be done directly through the Sag Harbor Cup Yachtscoring page.

6. THE COURSE

6.1 The race(s) will **START** in Noyack Bay and **FINISH** near Majors Point in Shelter Is. Sound.

6.2 The course(s) for each division will be selected by the Race Committee from the list of courses contained in the Sailing Instructions. Courses will be announced (VHF Channel 72) and posted by the RC on station prior to any start sequence. The race will be run in **Noyack Bay, Shelter Island Sound, Little Peconic Bay, Gardiner's Bay, or some variation of those locations.**

7. SCORING

7.1 All classes will be scored using time on time **using TCF = 650/(550 + PHRF).**

8. PRIZES

8.1 Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third in all divisions with at least 3 boats entered.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & SCRATCH SHEETS

9.1 Sailing Instructions **and Scratch Sheets** will be available through the Sag Harbor Cup Yachtscoring page and will be available from the Race Committee Boat prior to the regatta. Entrants will be notified by email of any changes to the Sailing Instructions **or Scratch Sheet** by 6pm on the day prior to the race, otherwise will be notified by the Race Committee Boat on the day of the Race.
