

NOTICE OF RACE 2016 MOUNT GAY ROUND BARBADOS RACE SERIES

January 16-24, 2016

Organised by The Barbados Cruising Club in association with Barbados Tourism Marketing Inc. and Mount Gay Rum.

1. Tradition

A race around Barbados on Errol Barrow Day, a national holiday in honor of the first Prime Minister of independent Barbados and a founding member of the Barbados Cruising Club. Absolute and class records have previously been recorded. 2016 marks the 80th anniversary of the "Round Barbados Race" and includes a wider programme of sailing and off the water activities.

2. The Rules

The Mount Gay Round Barbados Race Series will be governed by the rules as defined by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS) 2013-16, the CSA Rules, the J/24 Club of Barbados, the Notice of Race (except where any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

3. Handicapping

Race Days 1-3 (Coastal Course Racing): Both CSA and non-CSA classes will be determined. To be entered in a CSA class, yachts must hold a current valid CSA certificate.

Race Day 4 (The Mount Gay Round Barbados Race): The Mount Gay Round Barbados Race is a race to record absolute times with start times and classes determined by the Organising Committee. To be entered in the CSA class and be eligible to win the Rapier Trophy yachts must hold a current valid CSA certificate.

Race Day 5 (The Ocean Passage Race to Antigua) will be handicapped using the CSA measurement rule. Yachts must hold a current valid CSA certificate.

4. Advertising

The right to display advertising on a boat or by its crew while racing is permitted in accordance with Regulation 20.

6. Courses

Race Days 1-3 (Coastal Racing): Courses will be laid on the South and West Coasts of Barbados. One race is scheduled each day for the CSA Cruiser/Racers and non-CSA class. A maximum of four races is scheduled for the J24 class each day.

Race Day 4 (The Mount Gay Rum Round Barbados Race): Around Barbados 'north about' in a clockwise direction, returning to the same start/finish line. Approximately 60 miles.

Race Day 5 (The Ocean Passage Race to Antigua): Excluding Barbados, all islands south of La Desirade are to be taken to port. The finish will be between Fort Charlotte at the eastern entrance of English Harbour and a buoy to it's south. Approximately 300 miles.

7. Scoring

Race Days 1-3 (Coastal Racing): One race is required to validate the event. For CSA Racing, CSA Cruising and Non CSA rated classes a boat's score will be the total of all races. For the J/24 class, when 6 or more races have been competed, a boat's score shall be the total of her scores minus her worst score.

8. Prizes

Race Days 1-3 (Coastal Racing):

Prizes will be awarded in each class on the overall final results of this set of races.

Race Day 4 (The Mount Gay Round Barbados Race):

Prizes will be awarded in each racing class. Yachts that win a class and break an Absolute or Class record will win their Skipper's weight in Mount Gay Extra Old Rum. Perpetual trophies are engraved with the names of record breaking yachts from the Mount Gay Round Barbados Race and are displayed at the Barbados Cruising Club.

US\$2 per foot overall for the Ocean Passage Race to Antigua.

Entry forms received after 1200Hrs on 9th January 2016 will attract a US\$50 late payment penalty

Late entries will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
