NOTICE OF REGATTA SERIES

1. VENUE / AUTHORITY

- 1.1. The San Diego Yacht Club, in conjunction with Etchells Fleet 13 San Diego, invites members and associates of the International Etchells Class to the 2023 West Coast Spring Series (WCSS). Four individual regattas will be sailed on the waters off San Diego, south of Coronado and east of Point Loma in the Coronado Roads from March through May 2023. The Organizing Authority (OA) is Etchells Fleet 13 in conjunction with the San Diego Yacht Club (SDYC).
- 1.2. Visiting competitors who would like storage for and/or launch their Etchells or other vessels associated with this series at SDYC must contact the Dockmaster's Office *at least two weeks* prior to arriving. Persons in charge should contact David Randell at (619) 758-6308 or dockmaster@sdyc.org to arrange for storage and billing.
- 1.3. Etchells storage is available at SDYC on a limited basis and will be assigned on a first to request, first accepted basis. Fees may apply. Additional boat storage facilities in the vicinity to SDYC are available in the Point Loma area.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The 2023 International Etchells WCSS Regattas will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2. The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply: Rules 40, 60.3, 61.4, 67, 76.1 and Appendix R only.
- 2.3. The Bill Bennett Memorial (March 11 12, 2023) is classified as an "Open Event" under Appendix A of the International Etchells Class rules.
- 2.4. The Mid-Winters West (March 31 April 2, 2023), Pacific Coast Championships (Apr 29 30, 2023), and the National Championship/Orca Bowl (May 19 21, 2023) in the WCSS are classified as "Sanctioned Events Class C" under Appendix A of the International Etchells Class Association (IECA) Rules (https://etchells.org/class/technical/rules-documents/rules). The IECA Rules and Regulations will apply except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.5. The OA may require bow numbers to be installed on competing boats, if required bow numbers are provided.
- 2.6. All competing boats shall carry a handheld VHF radio capable of receive/transmit on assigned frequencies to be used exclusively for purposes of safety and Race Committee communications.
- 2.7. The Jury may impose suitable penalties, other than disqualification, for violations of non-Part 2 rules. This changes RRS 64.1.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The WCSS is open to members of the International Etchells Class. -All skipper and crew are required to be appropriate 2023 members of the IECA to participate in any WCSS event.
- 3.2. A Corinthian division will be established. The division will be open to boats whose skipper and crew hold a valid Group 1 Classification in accordance with ISAF Regulation 22 Sailor Classification Code at the time of the event. (Apply here: https://www.sailing.org/classification).
- 3.3. Boats should register and pay online in advance the prescribed entry fee for each regatta or the series as a whole by completing the online entry form. See NOR 4.0. Entries and full payment must be received no later than 1800 on the Wednesday preceding each regatta. Entries submitted later than the above dates and time may be accepted by the Organizing Authority subject to a \$50 late fee.

5. REGISTRATION

- 5.1. Registration for "Open Events" shall be as follows:
 - 5.1.1. Boats, rigs, and sails will not be measured, but shall be in compliance with IECA rules.
 - 5.1.2. Sail declarations will not be required.
 - 5.1.3. Competitor weigh-in will not be required.
- 5.2. Registration for "Sanctioned Events Class C" events shall be as follows:
 - 5.2.1. Boats, rigs, and sails will not be measured, but shall be in compliance with IECA rules.
 - 5.2.2. Each boat shall have a valid Sail Measurement Card, Hull Card, and insurance (see NOR 15.1) uploaded prior to registration to [https://form.jotform.com/melanieaalbers/etchells-WCSS]
 - 5.2.3. Competitors will declare from their sail card which sails they will use. No more than 1 mainsail, 2 spinnakers and 2 jibs, which have been previously measured will be used. Competitors can declare sails in person at registration or by entering the list of sails to [https://form.jotform.com/melanieaalbers/etchells-WCSS]
 - 5.2.4. Competitor's weigh-in will be required at registration check-in. There shall be three or four persons on each boat and their total combined weight in light clothing (at minimum outer wear shorts and t-shirt) at the time of registration shall be no more than 285 kg. (628.32 pounds).

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Sailing instructions will be available at registration, as well as on the regatta website and posted on the official notice board located on the east side (facing the water) of the SDYC Sailing Center.

7. COURSES

7.1. The course configuration will be windward–leeward and may include offset marks and gates.

8. PENALTIES

8.1. Appendix V1 is in effect.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. For each individual regatta, the Low Point scoring system will apply. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, the boat's score will be the total of her race scores. This change RRS A2.
- 9.2. To qualify for the overall 2023 WCSS awards, boats must count their place in the Midwinters West Regatta, and any two of the other three individual regattas (Bill Bennett Memorial Regatta, Pacific Coast Championships, and Orca Bowl/National Championship Regatta). Place scores from each individual regatta of the WCSS will be used with a Low Point Scoring System (1st Place = 1 point, 2nd Place = 2 points, 3rd Place = 3 points, etc.). The boat with the lowest score will be declared the winner of the 2023 West Coast Spring Series.
- 9.3. For the overall 2023 WCSS scoring, in the event one or more boats are tied after applying one throw out, the tiebreak winner(s) will be determined from the lowest regatta score at the Midwinters West Regatta.
- 9.4. A Corinthian class will be scored for those boats who meet NOR 3.2.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. For each individual regatta, the top three overall boats and the top three Corinthian boats will receive awards.
- 10.2. For the overall 2023 WCSS, the top three overall boats, and the top three Corinthian boats will receive awards.

11. TOWING

11.1. An attempt will be made to provide towing for competitors to the starting area if the wind is too light to sail. If available, tows will be made up in the Star Hoist Area and La Playa turning basin and will commence at approximately 0930. Towing is limited and will be available on a first come, first served basis. Please be ready with tow lines on a timely basis.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1. Coach and support boats must be registered with the OA prior to acting as a coach or support boat.
- 12.2. All registered coach and support boats will carry on board and operate while on the water a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF Channels and agree to assist the Race Committee if directed to do so.
- 12.3. Competitors shall have no communication with, and boats shall not be tied to, coach or support boats from 1120 each race day until racing has been concluded for the day. In the event of a postponement on shore, competitors shall have no communications with, and boats shall not be tied to, coach or support boats more than 90 minutes after the AP ashore is lowered. The time for AP down will be posted as a courtesy on the Notice Board located on the east side, of the Sailing Center. The Race Committee will make an announcement regarding this timing on the VHF Race channel. Between races, coach and support boats shall not approach, communicate with or transfer provisions or equipment to or from their supported boats unless in a medical or emergency requirement threatening the health of the crew or the flotation of the boat and only with the expressed permission of the Race Committee.

13. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

13.1. Hoisting facilities are available at SDYC. Boats shall be afloat no later than the warning signal of the first race for each regatta. Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta without an approved written request to the Principal Race Officer and the Technical Committee. This changes RRS 45.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1. The safety of a boat and her entire management shall be the sole inescapable responsibility of the owner/owners' representative. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage, illness, and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

15. **INSURANCE**

15.1. Each boat is required to hold adequate insurance including third-party liability insurance, and it is the owner or owners' representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event. Proof of insurance shall be supplied with each entry by uploading the policy declaration page to by [https://form.jotform.com/melanieaalbers/etchells-WCSS]
