NOTICE OF RACE ADDENDUM A J/109 CLASS REQUIREMENTS

This Addendum pertains to J/109 Class boats participating in the J/109 East Coast Regatta Series at the 2024 Cedar Point Yacht Club One Design Regatta.

- 1. **Regatta Designation:** This regatta is designated the Mandatory Event for the J/109 Class 2024 East Coast Regatta Series.
- 2. **Rules & Documents:** Race documents are posted on the regatta website. J/109 Class Rules (<u>CR</u>) are posted on the J/109 Class website at https://j109.org/.
- 2.1. **Membership and Eligibility:** All skippers and drivers shall be Voting Members or Associate Members of the J/109 Class and shall be listed as current year Voting or Associate Members on the J/109 website.
 - 3. **Measurement:** No formal measurement is scheduled. Boats may be protested by another competitor for non-compliance with the one design <u>CR</u>. Boats equipped with a bobstay must disable these for this regatta.
- 3.1. **Courtesy Measurement:** The J/109 Class Measurer will provide courtesy measurement checks that may be requested by sending an email to bill@j109.org. The courtesy checks will be performed at a mutually agreeable time between Thursday 30 May through Sunday 2 June in accordance with the 2024 North American Championship measurement checklist.
 - 4. **Number of Crew:** <u>CR</u> 6.1 shall apply limiting the number of crew members with no weigh-in requirements.
 - 5. **Corinthian Trophy:** In addition to the trophies specified in the NoR, the J/109 Class intends to award a Corinthian trophy to the J/109 with the best regatta score where the entire crew, including skipper, driver and all crew members are World Sailing Competitor Classification 1 (i.e., no Competition Category 3 crew on board).
- 5.1. **Sailor Classification Required for Corinthian Trophy:** Entry for the East Coast Regatta Series *Corinthian Trophy* is optional. Boats competing for the East Coast Regatta Series *Corinthian Trophy* shall have each skipper, driver, and crew member with a current World Sailing Sailor ID Number and World Sailing Sailor Classification available at https://www.sailing.org/sailors/sailor-categorisations/, and shall meet the World Sailing eligibility requirements of CR 2.2 2.4. The skipper shall declare the crew expected to sail during the regatta and shall enter the name, World Sailing ID Number and declared classification for each crew on the "owner's corner" of the regatta Yachtscoring website by end of day 29 May 2024. The declaration shall include crew & substitute crew that the skipper expects to use during the regatta.

NOTICE OF RACE ADDENDUM A J/109 CLASS REQUIREMENTS

- 5.1.1. **Substitute Crew for Corinthian Trophy:** If a skipper needs to provide for previously undeclared substitute crew, the skipper shall notify the Class Measurer of the name, crew position, World Sailing Sailor ID Number, and Competitor Classification of the substitute crew with the name of the crew member to be replaced not later than 0830 on the first day on which the substitute crew will sail.
 - 6. **East Coast Regatta Series Score:** The series score shall be calculated per the <u>East Coast Regatta Series Deed of Gift</u> which states no throwout is allowed for every event a boat competes.
