SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

2. Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located here:

3. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed in the vicinity of the clubhouse. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 mins after the AP is lowered.

- 4. Schedule
- 4.1 A competitors' meeting will be held at 1300, May 18th, in front of the SCC clubhouse
- 4.2 The warning signals for the first race will be at 1400 Subsequent races will be held as soon as practicable after the end of the previous race.
- 4.3 No initial warning signal will be made after 1900.

5. Starting Sequence

Races will be started with a 3 minute "Ollie Box" starting sequence which is as follows

3 min=3 horns

2 min=2 horns

1:30=1 long horn and 3 short horns

1:00=1 horn

:30=3 short horns

:10=1 horn

:5,4,3,2,1 short horns

START 1 long horn

6. Racing Area

The racing area is In Jamaica Bay Approximately 2 miles from SCC (see diagram)

7. Courses and Marks

The course will be windward leeward with a leeward gate and a start/finish Line In the middle of the leg. The course will either be once around or twice around which will either be hailed from the committee boat or a "1" or "2" displayed on the committee boat. (See attached diagram) The start/finish line is open.

8. Starting and Finishing Lines

The starting and finishing lines will be between a flag on the committee boat and the and the course side of the starting and finishing mark.

8.1 Finish in place


Committee may award finishing places to boats that are delaying the finish of the race. Finishing positions will be awarded based on the current position of boats. This changes rules 28.1, 35, A4, A5, and A11.


Protests


Protests shall be delivered to PRO within one hour after the race committee boat docks. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing in the clubhouse.


10. Scoring

As many races as are practical are scheduled. If at least four races are completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her series score. One race constitutes a series.
