



1. RULES

- 1.1. The organizing authority for this event is the Essex Corinthian Yacht Club.
- 1.2. The racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3. Appendix V (Alternative Penalties) is in effect.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the lower level of the ECYC Clubhouse as well as the Yacht Scoring website accessible through <u>www.essexcorinthian.org</u>.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Notice Board and on Yachtscoring before 0800, Saturday, September 21st.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1. Signals made ashore will be flown from the flagpole located on the waterfront located immediately north of the ECYC Clubhouse.

5. SCHEDULE of RACES

5.1. One race is scheduled, with the first warning signal at 1100.

6. CLASSES FLAGS

- 6.1. Class Flags are as follows:
 - 6.1.1. Class A Green Flag
 - $6.1.2. \quad Class \ B-Blue \ Flag$
 - 6.1.3. Class C Yellow Flag
 - 6.1.4. Class D White Flag

6.2. The fleet will be divided as determined by the RC (See scratch sheet online).

7. Communication and CHECK-IN

- 7.1. All boats must check in with the RC prior to First Warning by coming past the Signal boat. Radio check-ins will not be acknowledged.
- 7.2. A boat retiring from racing shall notify the RC as soon as possible.
- 7.3. The Race Committee will monitor VHF 71

8. THE START

- 8.1. The starting line shall be set west of Old Saybrook Outer Lighthouse.
- 8.2. The starting line shall be a line between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Signal boat and the nearby inflatable buoy.





9. COURSES

- 9.1. The Course will be designated by a series of marks posted in their order of rounding on the Course Board located on the Signal Boat.
- 9.2. A circle around the letter designates that mark is rounded to Starboard; noncircled designates Port rounding.

10. MARKS

10.1. Refer to Attachments A and B for listed marks and chart format.

11. THE FINISH

11.1 The finish line shall be a line between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Signal boat and the nearby inflatable mark.

12 TIME LIMIT

12.1 The time limit for all classes shall be 1630.

13. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 13.1 Protesting boats shall so indicate to the Signal Boat at the finish line.
- 13.2 Protests and Requests for Redress shall be delivered to the Race Committee (RC) within one hour after the Signal Boat has docked.

14. SCORING

14.1 Scores are determined based Time on Time method. TCF is calculated as: $TCF = \frac{650}{(550 + PHRF)}$.

15. PRIZES

15.1 The Essex Corinthian Yacht Club will award trophies to the top 3 finishers in each class. We will also present the "River vs Sound" award, which will award the best 3 performing boats from any River based club vs the best 3 performing boats from any Sound based club.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

16.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, see Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
