NOTICE OF RACE

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The Sailing Instructions will modify the following RRS: 28.1 & 31 (concerning limit marks), 60.3 (RC may protest regarding commercial traffic), 61.1 (notice of intent to protest), and 62 (announcing OCS).

J/105 Class Rules are modified by Article IX of the local J-105 Fleet-3 Article/Rules. This event is designated Level 1A. J-105 Fleet-3 Articles/Rules can be found at <https://www.j105fleet3.org/rules>

Safety: The US Sailing SER "Nearshore Safety Equipment Requirements" apply and confirm or supplement the USCG requirements and the Racing Rules of Sailing except as amended by specific class association rules.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to any boat. A current PHRF of the Chesapeake certificate, valid ORCi, ORC Club, or ORC Non-Spinnaker rating certificate or a CRCA class eligibility certificate is required for handicap racers.

Starts are planned for the classes below. The race committee may combine starts for some classes, depending on the number of entrants.

PHRF A,B,C PHRF N (twin headsails allowed)

ORC, ORC Racer/Cruiser, ORC Cruiser (Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker)

J/105 J/35 J/30 J/24 A-30 CAL 25

CRCA Racer, CRCA Cruiser

CHESSS (spin) CHESSS (no-spin)

Cruising Assigned Rating (ARC) does not qualify for CBYRA high point. Each class must have at least 3 starters to be scored separately. If less they will be scored as part of the handicap class most appropriate to their ratings.

Entry Due: Tuesday, 4 June 2024

Entry Fee: \$30 CBYRA members, \$35 CBYRA non-members

Late Fee: \$30 additional after Saturday, 1 June 2024

Notices: The official notice board will be located electronically on the event website.

Radio: Boats **SHALL** monitor VHF 73 for communications from the Race Committee. Flags and course boards may **NOT** be displayed to reduce RC staff.

Rendezvous: Saturday at 1600. In vicinity of Region 3 Mark X (bell R"2")
Check-in with Race Committee signal boat is required.

Signals: First warning at 1700. Class flags as defined in the 2024 CBYRA Green Book. Intended starting sequence will be posted by 2000 on Friday, 7 June at <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=16737>.

Courses: A distance race of 10 to 20 NM around government marks (Region 3 CBYRA marks). The courses will be displayed using placards on the RC signal boat and announced on VHF 73. In addition, an orange inflatable mark may be set as the first mark of the course and designated as mark "Z". If so, the signal boat will announce on VHF 73 a magnetic course from the start/finish area to mark "Z".

Scoring Corrected times for ORC classes will be calculated using ORC Time-on-Time ratings. The race committee will assign the course type and wind strength for scoring purposes on race day as detailed in the SIs.

Corrected times for PHRF classes will be calculated using PHRF Time-on-Time scoring. The A and B factors will be specified in the SIs. The race committee will assign the course type rating on race day as detailed in the SIs.

Start/Finish: At the start/finish location between the course side of a mark and an orange flag on the RC signal boat. Each yacht approaching the finish line at night is responsible for illuminating their sail numbers such that the Race Committee can identify them.

Time Limit: Midnight for all classes. Boats not finishing within one hour of the first boat in their class to finish will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.

Protests: Due online no later than 1200 on 9 June 2024. Protests heard starting on Friday 14 June 2024 online or via alternate arrangements.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7 & 4th/10+ starters. Awards will be distributed at a later date.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

Social: There is no post-race party planned.
