SPYC Boat of the Year, Ocean Racing Series and SPORC Event

The Organizing Authority is the St. Petersburg Yacht Club,

St. Petersburg, FL

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed as defined by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. In accordance with the WFPHRF Rules, this shall be a Race Category 4 event.
- 1.3. This regatta is an Official St. Petersburg Yacht Club Boat of the Year, Ocean Racing Series and S.P.O.R.C. event.
- 1.4. As allowed by RRS 88.2, the US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2, and 63.4 do not apply to these classes.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2.2. Advertising shall be restricted to World Sailing Advertising Code 20.2.2, 20.2.3.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. Classes will be Spinnaker, Racer/Cruiser, Cruiser, Double-Handed and Multi-Hull Class.
- 3.2. Spinnaker Classes shall hold a current and valid ORC certificate. All other classes shall have a current WFPHRF certificate. (Specific information regarding Spinnaker Class scoring is addressed in 9.3) There must be a minimum of 4 boats per class to constitute a class. Any class with less than four will be placed in the appropriate ORC or WFPHRF class within their division.
- 3.3. Skippers in Cruiser division must declare their intent to use an asymmetrical spinnaker or a cruising chute no later than 1700, Thursday, October 31, 2024, by notifying the Event Chair.
- 3.4. All entries must be done on Yacht Scoring.
- 3.5. Each entry must include a complete and accurate list of all crew participating in this event.
- 3.6. Waivers must be signed electronically by the skipper and all crew on Yacht Scoring.
- 3.7. No boats' entry will be final without a completed and signed online (YS) waiver from each participating crew member. If there is a crew member substitution, that crew member must complete and sign an online (YS) waiver.
- 3.8. No boat will be scored without completing all entry requirements.

4. Fees

- 4.1. Entry fees paid prior to 1700 October 18, 2024 - \$90.00 (tax included)
- 4.2. Entry fees paid after 1700 October 18, 2024, but before October 31, 2024 - \$110.00 (Tax included)
- 4.3. Deadline for entries is **1700** October 31, **2024**. Entries after 1700 Wednesday, October 31, 2024, will be accepted solely at the discretion of the Organizing Authority with an explanation of why and will pay an additional (non-refundable) late fee of \$50.00.
- 4.4. Entry Fee includes two tickets to the Saturday After-Race Party
- 4.5. Boats that entered and withdraw in writing prior to Wednesday October 31, 2024, will receive a refund of the entry fee less an administrative fee of \$25.00.

5. Schedule

- 5.1. Friday, November 1, 2024 – Registration will be done electronically online. If you have questions, email us through Yacht Scoring.
- 5.2. Skippers meeting, if needed, will be held either electronically or in person.
- 5.3. Pre-Race landside activities will be at the St Petersburg Yacht Club, 11 Central Avenue, St. Petersburg, Florida.
- 5.4. Race Schedule: The Race Committee will attempt to have one race on Saturday, November 2, 2024, for all racing classes. One race shall constitute a regatta.
- 5.5. First Warning will be @11:00 Saturday, November 2, 2024.
- 5.6. November 2, 2024- Complimentary waffles will be served in the SPYC dock gathering area as yachts and competitor's finish.

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1. The sailing instructions will be available on SPYC website and on Yacht Scoring by Friday, November 1, 2024.

7. Courses

- 7.1. All classes will do a Random Leg (RLC) at a distance of approximately 60NM.
- 7.2. The Course to be sailed will be included in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Penalty Systems

- 8.1. The scoring penalty, RRS Rule 44.3, (a), (b), (c), will apply.
- 8.2. Competitors must complete the Alternative Penalty Acknowledgement Form and turn it in prior to the end of a 2-hour protest period.

9. Scoring

- 9.1. The Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except no race will be excluded.
- 9.2. Spinnaker Classes will be scored ORC, all purpose for this regatta.
- 9.3. The WFPHRF RLC Rating will be used for all classes except Spinnaker.

10. Berthing

- 10.1. SPYC docks may be under construction at the time of this event. We are exploring possible alternatives for vessels that may require dockage. More information will be forthcoming. Parking in the SPYC garage is prohibited for non-members.
- 10.2. Parking is available in the city parking lot south of the club.

11. Radio Communications

- 11.1. Except in the event of an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive communications not available to all boats, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions. This restriction also applies to cell phones.
- 11.2. The Official Bulletin board will be Yacht Scoring. All competitors shall have a way to access YS to receive all communications posted.
- 11.3. The Race Committee may use RRS90.2(C) to make changes to the NOR and/or the Si's on the water.

12. Awards

- 12.1. Awards will be given as follows. Classes will be divided into divisions according to the number of entries.
- 12.2. First, Second and Third place awards will be given for each class in the MOA Race. Other special awards will be given out as deemed by the organizing authority and regatta organizers.

13. Disclaimer of Liability and Personal Conduct

- 13.1.** Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS 3 "Decision to Race." The organizing authority, the sponsors, the race committee, officers, and board of directors of the SPYC, and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.
- 13.2.** The Skipper/Owner of each boat participating in the Regatta shall be responsible for the behavior of each member of the crew of his/her boat both on the water and while ashore. The failure of any of those persons to comply with all federal, state, and local government regulations as well as the St. Petersburg Yacht Club policies or with any reasonable request of the Organizing Authority, Race Officers or their representatives may result in the disqualification of the boat and its exclusion from the Regatta. This modifies RRS 76.
- 13.3.** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$500,000 per incident or the equivalent.
