THE INTERCOLLEGIATE OFFSHORE REGATTA NOTICE OF RACE

Organized by The Storm Trysail club Hosted by The Larchmont Yacht Club Presented by Prestige Toyota OCTOBER 11 & 12, 2008 at LARCHMONT YACHT CLUB, LARCHMONT, NY

1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (2005-2008)

2. ELIGABILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 Entry will be by invitation from The Storm Trysail Club.
- 2.2 All team members must be undergraduate students of the college or university that their team represents.

3. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, Oct. 11th Sunday, Oct. 12th 0900: Skipper's Meeting 0930: First Warning

1100: First Warning 1400: No race started after this time.

- **4. CLASSES:** Boats will race as one-design classes. The Class Flag for each class will be the numeral pennant for the class number indicated on the scratch sheet.
- **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be emailed to entrants approximately one week prior to the event and be available in printed form at the Skipper's Meeting.
- **6. VENUE:** The race area will be in western Long Island Sound to the south and east of Larchmont Harbor.
- 7. COURSES: Courses will be windward-leeward.
- **8. PENALTY SYSTEM:** The Scoring Penalty (RRS 44.3) will apply. The penalty will be two places.

9. SCORING:

- 9.1 One race shall constitute the series.
- 9.2 Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.3 Boats failing to finish within the time limit will be scored TLE (Time Limit Expired) and receive points equal to the number of boats that finished within the time limit plus two (2).
- 9.4 Overall series winners will be determined by the highest winning percentages of the class winners. Winning percentage is calculated by dividing a boat's high point score by the maximum number of points available (# of boats x number of races).

10. PRIZES:

- 10.1 Series prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each class.
- 10.2 Overall series prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded to the top three class winners based on winning percentage.
- 10.3 The class winner with the highest winning percentage will be awarded THE PAUL HOFFMANN TROPHY.
- 11. LIABILITY: The decision to participate in the Intercollegiate Offshore Regatta is the sole responsibility of each participant and not that of The Storm Trysail Club or Larchmont Yacht Club. As a condition of participation in this event, each participant, boat owner and boat owner's representative will be required to sign an individual waiver releasing The Storm Trysail Club, The Larchmont Yacht Club, their officers, directors, employees, sponsors and agents from all claims, actions, causes of action and suits whatsoever, in law, admiralty or equity.
