

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AMENDMENT 2

Amendments in italics

1 RULES

1.4 is amended as follows: *Under the requirements of US SER 3.19.1: A removable, electronic compass meets this requirement. In 3.24.3, delete reference to 3.24.1.*

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1The first sentence is amended as follows:
- 3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted **by** 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.4 is amended as follows
- 4.4 The race committee will broadcast its intent to the *three* divisions on the appropriate VHF channels at 0900 and again at 0930.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 The first sentence is amended as follows:

Racing is scheduled each day from Monday, January 16 through Friday, January 20. For classes racing on Divisions 1 and 3 (except for the Multihull and Performance Cruising Classes racing one race a day) ten (10) races are scheduled of which three must be completed to constitute a series.

6 CLASS FLAGS, EVENT BOW NUMBERS & STICKERS AND SAIL NUMBERS

6.4 The first sentence is amended as follows:

Bow numbers will be required for the *J/111*, *C&C30*, *J/70* and *Flying Tiger 7.5m* classes only.

The Race Committee has given permission to the Flying Tiger 7.5m Class to race without sail numbers.

18 SCORING

18.2 is amended as follows:

18.2 ORC class will be scored using time on time using the Triple Number option for Windward / Leeward. The Performance Cruising class shall be scored using time on time using the Single Number option for Offshore.

18.3 is added:

18.3 For the ORC Class, the Race Committee plans to announce on VHF, its intention to use either the Low, Medium or High Number before the warning signal of each race. In the event the wind velocity changes during the race, the Race Committee may change the number for scoring the race.

24 RADIO COMMUNCATION

24.3 The first sentence is amended as follows:

Delete "during that time frame"
