### **RULES**

The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the regulations of the Caribbean Sailing Association (CSA), the Virgin Islands Sailing Association (VISA), and class rules, except as any of those are changed by the sailing instructions. The Regatta is designated Category C.

### **PROPOSED CLASSES**

CSA Racing Spinnaker	Multi-Hull	Rhodes 19	VX One
CSA Non-spinnaker	Jib & Main	Melges 32	IC 24

Minimum class size is 3 registered boats. The organizing authority reserves the right to combine, cancel, subdivide, create, or rearrange classes.

### **ENTRY**

Eligible entrants are encouraged to complete the St. Croix Yacht Club (SCYC) entry registration form and submit by mail, fax, or online at [www.stcroixyc.com/regatta/](http://www.stcroixyc.com/regatta/). **The entry fee is \$150.** Payment is due at Registration check in no later than 1800, November 11, 2015. Eligibility requirement for boats is a current CSA rating, except for one design classes.

### **COURSES**

Racing will take place off the north shore of St. Croix. Courses to be sailed will be included in the sailing instructions.

### **SCORING**

The Low Point Scoring system, Appendix A, will apply. There may be as many as twelve races, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.

## PRIZES

First through third place prizes will be awarded for each class for Captain Nick's Race. Series Prizes for the International Regatta (Saturday and Sunday's competition) will be awarded to the first three places in each class with the perpetual award for 1<sup>st</sup> in Racing Spinnaker and the Richard Newick Perpetual Award for 1<sup>st</sup> place Multihull

**The skipper's weight in rum will be awarded to first place for each class with 7 or more entries for Saturday and Sunday's series scores.**
