# ADDENDUM TO THE 2016 NASSAU CUP NOTICE OF RACE

This addendum is for the purpose of adding the Multihull Class to this NOR

# 1.0 VENUE / AUTHORITY / CLASSES / DATES

#### Delete:

1.1 The Nassau Cup Ocean Race is a 176 nm. invitational ocean race for ocean racing monohull boats. Classes invited to compete include **IRC** rated boats, **ORC Club** rated boats, and **PHRF** boats with ratings from PHRF of Southeast Florida.

# Replace with;

1.1 The Nassau Cup Ocean Race is a 176 nm. Invitational ocean race for ocean racing monohull and multihull boats. Classes invited to compete include **IRC** rated boats, **ORC Club** rated boats, **PHRF** boats with ratings from PHRF of Southeast Florida, and ocean racing multihull boats with ratings from Multihull Association of South Florida (MASF). Classes will be established with a minimum of three paid entries in a class.

### 4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND RATINGS

## Add;

4.5 **Multihull** ocean racing/cruising type boats at least 30 feet LOA minimum with enclosed cabins and permanent accommodations, having submitted a completed entry form and a current valid MASF/PHRF Certificate obtained from MASF are invited. The Race Committee reserves the right to reject any entry that does not comply with their definition of an "ocean racing/cruising type" Multihull boat. #### 8.0 RATINGS

## Delete;

8.1 A current IRC, ORC Club, or PHRF of Southeast Florida rating certificate is required for each boat.

## Replace with;

8.1 A current IRC, ORC Club, PHRF of Southeast Florida or MASF of South Florida rating certificate is required for each boat.

# 9.0 DIVISIONS & CLASSES

#### Delete:

9.1 The fleet may be divided into IRC, ORC Club, and PHRF divisions with as many classes as dictated by the total number of entries.

#### Replace with;

9.1 The fleet may be divided into IRC, ORC Club, PHRF, and MASF classes as dictated by the number of entries. A minimum of three (3) boats entered and paid is required to establish a class.

#### 13.0 TIME ALLOWANCES

## Delete;

- 13.2 For the **PHRF** division, Time-on-Time scoring will be used. Time allowances for PHRF Division boats will be calculated using the following conversion formula: **650** /( **550 + PHRF Rating**)
- 13.3 For the PHRF division, a boats calculated Time on Time rating allowance will be applied as a factor of the boats elapsed time for the race.

#### Replace with;

- 13.2 For the PHRF and MASF divisions, Time-on-Time scoring will be used. Time allowances will be calculated using the following conversion formula: 650 /( 550 + PHRF (or MASF) Rating)
- 13.3 For the PHRF and MASF divisions, a boats calculated Time on Time rating allowance will be applied as a factor of the boats elapsed time for the race.
