## **Amendment to Sailing Instructions No. 1**

The Regatta Venue and the Regatta Office are at Cowes Yacht Haven, Cowes

### **4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

#### **4.2**

Delete

'When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in race signal AP. This changes RRS Race Signals'

Insert

'When flag AP is displayed ashore boats shall not leave the Regatta Venue. The warning signal will be made not less than 45 minutes after the lowering of the AP. This changes RRS Race Signals AP'

### **10. MARKS**

#### **10.2**

Delete 'New marks, as provided in SI 12.1, will be black inflated triangular.'

Insert 'New marks, as provided in SI 12.1, will be orange inflated triangular.'

### **11. THE START**

11.1

Add

'A protection mark may be laid near to the race committee vessel with a staff displaying an orange flag at the port end of the starting line. If laid, the protection mark shall rank as a start mark and shall be left on the same required side as the committee vessel.'

## **27. TRACKING**

Add 27.2 and 27.3

27.2 Competitors shall sign out and shall collect their trackers at the Etchells container before going afloat on each day of the regatta and shall sign in and shall return their trackers at the Etchells container after racing each day within the time limit for protests.

27.3 A boat not complying with 27.2 above will be penalised:

- a) First offence minimum £25 donation to the local RNLI.
- b) Second and subsequent offences the penalty may be disqualification or some other penalty as determined by the international jury.
