The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the regulations of the Caribbean Sailing Association (CSA), the CSA Minimum Safety Requirements, the Virgin Islands Sailing Association (VISA), and IC-24 class rules, except as any of those are changed by the sailing instructions. The Regatta is designated Category C.

ENTRY

Eligible entrants are encouraged to complete the St. Croix Yacht Club (SCYC) entry registration form and submit by mail, fax, or online at www.stcroixregatta.com. The entry fee is \$300, except for Beachcats and Rhodes 19, whose entry fee is \$200. Payment is due at Registration check in no later than 1800, February 19, 2010. Eligibility requirement for boats is a current CSA rating, except for Multihulls and one design classes.

Racing will take place off the north shore of St. Croix, USVI. Courses to be sailed will be included in the sailing instructions.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring system, Appendix A, will apply. A2 is modified so that no scores will be excluded. There may be as many as twelve races, of which two shall be completed to constitute a series.

PRIZES

Prize giving will take place in the Regatta tent. Prizes will be awarded to the first three places in each class. The perpetual trophy will be awarded to the winner of Spinnaker Racing A.
