6. Classes and Order of Starts

Start	Class	Class Flag
1	Beneteau First 36.7	Class logo, or #1
2	C&C 35 Mark I	Class logo, or #2

9. Starting – The warning signal for the first class on the "C" Course will be at 1030 hours.

C1. Course Location – The starting area bears approximately 080 degrees magnetic, 4.0 miles from the Peche Island Range Rear Light.

C3. Courses – Only the Long "C" course will be used. All other course descriptions of C3 apply.

C5. Number of Races – The Race Committee intends to run four races as time and conditions permit, but no warning signal will be made after 1500 hours.
