Eligibility: This race is open to sail yachts owned or chartered by individual members of clubs or associations that are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA, or US Sailing, and who have paid their race fees.

Registration: *This race is free for North Star Sail Club members.* Registration shall be submitted according to registration instructions on YachtScoring.com (also available through the NSSC web site NorthStarSail.org/Racing). Completed entry forms shall be received by 1200 on the day prior to the event. The entry fee for non-North Star boats for this race is \$30.00. Late entries will be accepted and will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

Classes: JAM, Asymmetrical, and Spinnaker classes. Class splits will be posted at NSSC clubhouse no later than 2 hours before the race. Five boats are required for a class.

Schedule: The race is scheduled for September 10, 2017. The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 1230.

Ratings: If a boat does not have a current DRYA rating certificate, the RC will assign a temporary rating as described in the ABYRA Handbook.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be posted on YachtScoring.com (also available through the NSSC web site NorthStarSail.org/Racing) no later than one week prior to the event. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 1000 on the day of the race. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the online notice board for notices.

Course: The course will be on Anchor Bay. Course selection will be visually communicated to competitors prior to the warning signal. Available course configurations and visual signals are described in the ABYRA Handbook but may be changed by the Sailing Instructions.

Scoring: Races will be scored using time-on-time over PHRF for classes and division overall.

Awards: Overall and class awards will be presented following the races.
