ASW REQUIREMENTS FOR CLUB CLASS

Amend Sailing Instruction 1.2 as follows: Add: 1.2(e) for the Club Class, ASW Club Class Rules.

ASW Club Class Rules

The Class will be run as follows:

- The Class will be scored using Progressive Handicapping. All entrants will be provided with a CSA Simplified Rating prior to the first day of racing. After racing, the speed of each boat relative to every other boat will be calculated by the results program and individual ratings will be adjusted accordingly on a daily basis and expressed as a performance index. The calculation is based on an internationally recognized and used program and will not be subjective.
- All class participants must accept the Progressing Handicapping procedures. Otherwise, they would be more suited to a CSA racing class. Acceptance of entries into the Club Class is solely at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- There will be one or two races per day for the Class. Only single headsail with or without pole will be allowed. No downwind sails, including mizzen staysails, are acceptable.
