2. COURSE

2.1. Yachts proceeding offshore in Wilmette area are advised that Sheridan Shore Yacht Club will be conducting local races with starts at 1300. It is requested that racing yachts remain well clear of their starting area and in particular the starting line off Wilmette Point.

2.2.1. 26.2 Nautical Miles. NOTE - this race will be scored PHRF: Time on Time.

4.1. A Multi-Hull section will be included and scored as it's own entity. The Multi-Hull boats will race one another only and not be included in overall fleet scoring with the mono hull boats. The Multi-Hull section will start with the LMPHRF 1 section.

5. FINISHING

5.1. The finish mark is the green lighted Buoy #3 located approximately 0.5 n.m. east of the Waukegan Lighthouse Pierhead. The finish mark will be located at approximately N 42.21.70 latitude and W 87.47.90 longitude. The RC may set a guard mark near the committee boat and yachts may not pass between the guard mark and the committee boat. Yachts are also advised that there may be a pin boat at the pin end of the finish line and yachts may not pass between the pin boat and the pin.

5.2. READ THIS - IT IS IMPORTANT! Due to the problem of visibility caused by the afternoon sun, the committee boat will station at the west end of the finish line. Leave the mark to starboard.

5.3. Sail Number Boards must be displayed on the PORT side at the finish. The material used in the construction of Sail Number Boards is optional.

6. ALTERNATE FINISHING

6.1. In the absence of a Race Committee, boats shall finish by crossing Latitude N 42-21.70 between W 87-47.90 and 87-47.97 Longitude. Upon crossing this alternate finish line, boats shall provide their finish time (according to their GPS time) to the RC via email. This modifies the US Sailing Prescription to RRS 34. In the event that an alternate finish line is to be used, the RC shall broadcast that information on VHF Channel 78 beginning at 1200 hrs. on 6/17/2017 and repeating at approximately 30 minute intervals.

7. TIME LIMIT

7.1. Shall be 1800 hours, 6/17/2017 plus the amount of time of any postponement for a yacht's class. Only yachts crossing the finish line by their class's time limit will be considered as finishing. This changes RRS 35. Non finishers MUST notify WYC RC via Channel 78 or telephone to WYC 847-623-4188.

8. PRIZES

8.1. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, Line honors, & the overall winner, flags will be awarded on 6/17/2017, if possible, after scoring is complete subject to number of boats in a section. Scoring will be posted at the yacht club upon completion.
