SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - AMENDMENT #1
July 29 - Gold Star Regatta Distance Race -- JPYC

1. COURSE

The marks and the order in which the marks are to be passed are at the end of these instructions. All marks are to be left to PORT. The official length of the course shall be determined by the Race Committee and shall not be grounds for redress.

The course selected will be displayed from a sign-board on the Race Committee Signal Boat with or before the Warning Signal.

Course: Start – 2.3 miles north of the 68th Street Crib – Four Mile Crib – Finish -1/2 Mile East of the 68th Street Crib - Distance 8.41 nautical miles.

The start will be approximately . N 41 49.45 W 87 31.10.

The finish will be approximately . N 41 47.18 W 87 31.10.

FIRST WARNING WILL BE AT 10:30; IT IS YET TO BE DETERMINED THE NUMBER OF STARTS, PLEASE REFER TO THE YACHT SCORING OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD FRIDAY EVENING, JULY 28TH.

3 FINISHING

The Finish Line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee Signal Boat and a white finishing mark.

No finish report will be required.

Time Limit will be 15:00; please monitor Channel 78 VHF for any shorten course changes.
