## NOTICE OF RACE

## 1.0 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta is organized under the authority of the Lauderdale Yacht Club and will be sailed under the management of the Lauderdale Yacht Club Race Committee. The regatta will be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the prescriptions of US Sailing except those of RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4, the rules of the C & C 30 Class, the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and properly posted amendments thereto. The US Sailing prescriptions are available at <a href="https://www.ussailing.org">www.ussailing.org</a>,
- 1.2 The regatta will conform to the current World Sailing Regulation 20 and the respective Class Rules.

### 2.0 REGISTRATION / CLASSES

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the C & C 30 One Design Class.
- 2.2 Eligible Boats shall enter by completing the online entry process available on the event website and paying the required fees. On-line entry opens on November 01, 2017. Entry in the event is not final until registration is completed. All competitors must check in on site to complete registration.
- 2.3 On Site Registration and Check-in for competitors is scheduled for the Thursday of each race weekend between 1600-1830 and on Friday between 0800-0900, at the LYC Sailing Center.

## 3.0 ENTRY FEES

3.1 Fees are stated in US Dollars and include Florida State Sales Tax. Entries received 14 days before the first day of racing for each event weekend will be \$ 1,500 per boat. After that day there will be an additional \$ 250 added to the entry fee.

## 4.0 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The briefing for competitors is scheduled for the Thursday of each event weekend at the Lauderdale Yacht Club Pavilion at 1830.
- 4.3 The First Warning Signal for racing each day is 1100. On the last day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1430. The Awards ceremony will follow the close of the protest deadline at the Lauderdale Yacht Club Pavilion on Sunday for each event.

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available online on or before the competitors briefing and will include sample courses. Other documents for the event will be published with the sailing instructions.

## 7.0 SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A, will apply, modified so that each boats event score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if six or more races have been completed for that event. Eight races are scheduled for each weekend event of which three races shall be completed to constitute an event.
- 7.2 The series will be scored using the best three event final scores for each boat (of the four events). An event score will be the final position in that event not the scored points.

#### 8.0 SUPPORT BOATS

- 8.1 All support boats must register on-line or in-person.
- 8.2 Coaches and Support boats are required to monitor the course channel on a VHF radio and be available to assist with safety when requested.

### 9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats.

# 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The Lauderdale Yacht Club and organizers will not be liable for material damage, loss, death, or personal injury in conjunction with the event.
