

Whidbey Island Race Week 2018
Performance Cruising Class
Sailing Instructions Addendum

Preamble: The intent of the Performance Cruising Class is to open the joys of WIRW to the less serious racer and boat. There will be one race a day over long distance courses. Sailors will take their own rounding and finishing times and report them upon return to WIRW HQ. The Sailing Instructions are intended to allow all boats to race, finish, and enjoy the event.

1. The course will be emailed and sent by text message each morning at least 15 minutes before the race and will include a list of rounding marks (to be left to port) consisting of WIRW temporary marks, and other charted marks. WIRW temporary marks are defined in the main sailing instructions. Charters marks will include GPS coordinates.
2. The start will be the start as described in the sailing instructions
3. The finish will be a line extending magnetic west from the R4 mark at the entrance of Oak Harbor.
4. Each boat must take their own time and record it on their rounding times form at each mark.
5. Races will be scored PHRF Time-on-Time
6. Scoring:
 - a. If 50% of the boats that started do not make it to the finish, the boats' times at the last mark that 50% of the fleet reached will be used for scoring.
 - b. Boats that do not make it to the last mark described in 6a will be finished after boats that did, in descending order from the furthest mark reached. If more than one boat reaches a mark other than the finish, their position will be determined based on corrected time.
7. Rounding mark times and finish times must be turned into WIRW HQ, or handed to Charley Rathkopf by 1800 on Thursday and Saturday, 1900 on Friday, and 1700 on Sunday for boats to be scored in the race. Boats may and should use their engines to reach race headquarters by this deadline, but marks or the finish passed while under power should not be recorded.

These sailing instructions change RRS 35 (time limits) and A5 (Scores Determined by the Race Committee).
