

# 2018 Hillsborough Bay Race

## NOTICE OF RACE

"Come Hell or high water" was the phrase used by our first regatta chair, Brian Malone. This distance race is held in Hillsborough Bay, but don't assume it is just an afternoon cruise. Test your navigation skills and plan to race even if the weather pipes up. This time of year is prone to fronts. In the internet age, most race decisions are made at the bar watching radar. You can plan to race this one and hone your heavy weather skills, so don't shy away if there is a blow.

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 All PHRF classes will use the Scoring Penalty of rule 44.3.

#### 2 FLIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing on-line entry and paying the required fees at www.diyc.org.
- 2.2 The regatta is open to all boats with a valid WFPHRF certificate or a "provisional" DIYC rating assigned by the DIYC Fleet Captain.
- 2.3 PHRF classes include: Spinnaker, Racer Cruiser, Non-Spinnaker, Cruising and Multihull (at the discretion of the Race Committee, to be placed in appropriate monohull class if not enough entries for a separate class)
- 2.4 Under West Florida PHRF rules, this is a Category 4 event.
- 2.5 Cruising spinnakers are permitted for the Cruising Class. All Cruising Class boats intending to use a cruising spinnaker must declare so no later than 1100 on March 24th either by email to fleetcaptain@diyc.org or by informing the registration desk staff during registration hours.
- 2.6 Boats may enter on-line at www.diyc.org. Boats may also enter, in person, at DIYC during registration hours.

#### 3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$50.00
- 3.2 The entry fee excludes state and local taxes.

## 6 COURSES

- 6.1 A single distance race in Hillsborough Bay not to exceed 20 nm. Start will be in the vicinity of Davis Island "A" mark and finish at the Davis Island Basin entrance between the two range posts.
  - Any boat not finished by 1800 Sat. March 4 will be scored DNF.

7.1 All handicap racing will be scored TOD using West Florida PHRF ratings:

Spinnaker Classes RLC Rating
Non Spinnaker Class RLC Rating
Multihull Class RLC Rating
Racer Cruiser Class RLC Rating
Cruising Class RLC Rating

8.1 Awards ceremony and party will follow the event on March 24 at 1700 at the Regatta Bar downstairs. All divisions will receive awards based on the entries in each division:
