SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - AMENDMENT #1 -- Spring Opener Buoy Race --

1. GENERAL

1.1. The Edwin Reinholtzen Spring Opener will use the CCYC's Olympic circle with the courses configured for a trapezoid, as outlined, below. (Please note that the Olympic Cup, held on Sunday, is a separate event but will also be raced at or near SA1.) These two days of racing have been designated by CCYC as the Rossberger Regatta to honor Past Commodore and long-time member, Bill Rossberger. The Rossberger Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the regatta as selected by the organizing authority. The winner's name will be inscribed on the trophy which will remain on display at CCYC.

3. COURSE

3.1. Metro Olympic Course with Fixed Marks. An Olympic course is located around the Starting Area SA1. Eight marks are located at 45° intervals in a circle around the central mark starting from 000° through 315°T. They are designated "N", "NE", "E", "SE", "S", "SW", "W", and "NW". The color of the marks are white with red and orange stripes. The NE, SE, SW, and NW marks also have a yellow stripe. The color of the mark located at the center is solid orange. The Race Committee shall fly code flag "E" or "Q" to designate a course as outlined in the diagrams. Additionally, the Race Committee will use English language letters on a placard to indicate the first mark of the course. The Race Committee may choose to drop an inflatable mark to designate the starting and finishing mark. When using an inflatable mark as the starting mark, the Race Committee shall set the starting line approximately 0.20 to 0.25 nautical miles to windward or leeward of the starting area mark.

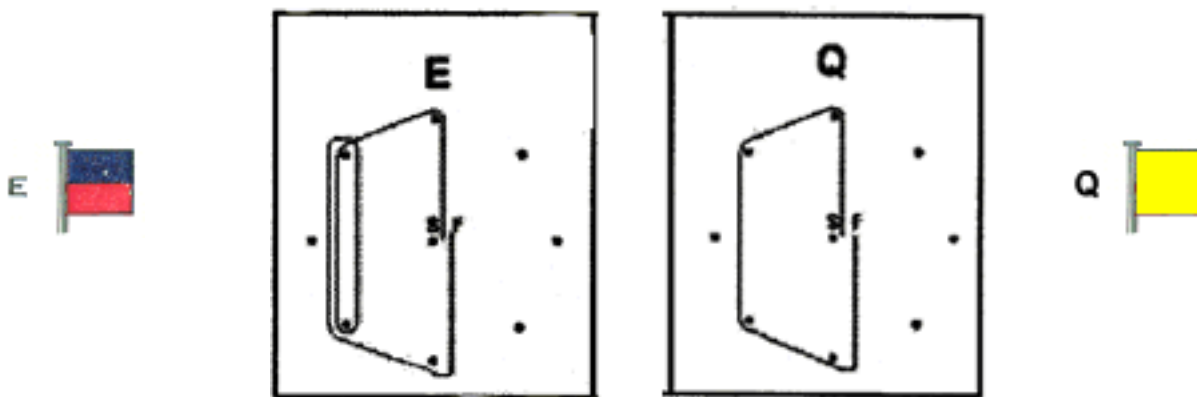
