SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - AMENDMENT #1 July 7 – Gold Star Regatta Distance Race -- JPYC

1. COURSE

The marks and the order in which the marks are to be passed are at the end of these instructions. The William Dever Crib and Four Mile Crib are to be left to STARBOARD. The official length of the course shall be determined by the Race Committee and shall not be grounds for redress.

The course selected will be displayed from a sign-board on the Race Committee Signal Boat with or before the Warning Signal.

Course: Course 1 Start Appx 128° T, 1.1 NM from Chicago Harbor Light – Four Mile Crib – Finish -1/2 Mile East of the 68th Street Crib - Distance 6.7 nautical miles. This changes GSI 8.

Course 2 Start Appx 128° T, 1.1 NM from Chicago Harbor Light – William Dever Crib – Finish -1/2 Mile East of the 68th Street Crib - Distance 10.3 nautical miles. This changes GSI 8.

The start will be approximately . N 41° 52.80 W 87° 34.46.

The finish will be approximately . N 41° 46.80 W 87° 32.80.
