

2011 I-LYA SAIL REGATTA

August 5-7, 2011

Organizing Authority – Inter-Lake Yachting Association

Host – Put-in-Bay Yacht Club, Put-in-Bay, Ohio

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2012*.
- 1.2. RRS 49.2 is changed to read “On boats equipped with upper and lower lifelines of wire or other material, a competitor sitting on the deck facing outward with his waist inside...”
- 1.3. RRS 60.1(a) is changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership.
- 1.4. The first sentence of RRS A2 is changed to read “Each boat’s series score shall be the total of her race scores.”
- 1.5. In the event of a conflict between the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail. This changes RRS 63.7.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, AND PLACEMENT

- 2.1. This event is open to members of US SAILING or other National Authorities, members of recognized yacht clubs, members of recognized sailing class associations, and others as may be designated by the Organizing Authority.
- 2.2. The Organizing Authority shall, at its sole discretion, and whose decision is final and without appeal, determine eligibility and placement within divisions.
- 2.3. Eligible boats shall register using online registration or by mailing the completed entry form together with all fees and the appropriate, valid rating-measurement certificate, in time to arrive by the specified deadlines.
- 2.4. Online registration and mail-in forms are available at www.i-lya.org
- 2.5. Competitors not registering online shall mail their completed registration to:

- 2.6. Deadlines for receipt of registration materials are as follows:
 - 2.6.1. All divisions except Centerboards & Multihulls – 2359 hours, Sunday, July 24, 2011
 - 2.6.2. Centerboard & Multihull Divisions – 2359hours, Sunday, July 24, 2011
- 2.7. The acceptance of registrations received after the specified deadline is at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority and, if accepted, is subject to a late fee of \$35.00
- 2.8. All boats shall deliver a completed and signed “Waiver of Liability” form either with their completed mail-in registration or to the regatta office at the Put-in-Bay Yacht Club no later than 2100 hours on Thursday, August 4, 2011.

3. FEES

3.1. The required fees are as follows:

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

4.1. Multiple back-to-back races are scheduled each day

4.2. The time of the first warning signal for each course will be as follows on the following dates:

5. MEASUREMENT

5.1. Each boat shall conform to its class rules.

5.2. In handicapped classes, except for boats without a current measurement/rating certificate from a PHRF fleet associated with US PHRF, boats registering online, and boats registering in the Casual Cruising division, all boats shall provide, with their registration a copy of their current (2011) measurement certificate.

5.2.1. Boats registering online shall either mail to the Registrar no later than the registration deadline or deliver to the Regatta Office at the Put-in Bay Yacht Club no later than 2100 hours on Thursday August 4, 2011, a copy of their measurement/rating certificate.

5.2.2. Boats without a current certificate on file will be assigned a temporary rating at the discretion of the Organizing Authority which shall be valid for this regatta only and cannot be appealed.

5.3. A boat and/or its equipment may be inspected, or directed to a place for inspection, at any time for compliance with Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions, and this Notice of Race.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Race packets, including Sailing Instructions will be available on Thursday, August 4, 2011 from 1800-2100 hours at the Put-in-Bay Yacht Club.

7. VENUE

7.1. All racing will take place on the open waters of western Lake Erie and its islands.

8. COURSES

- 8.1. PHRF and JAM Divisions will sail a combination of Windward-Leeward and Offshore Around the Islands courses
- 8.2. One-Design Keelboat Division will sail Windward-Leeward courses.
- 8.3. Centerboard and Catamaran Division will sail a combination of Windward-Leeward and Triangle courses.
- 8.4. Casual Cruising Division will sail Offshore Around the Islands courses.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. The Low-Point System of Appendix A will be used.
 - 9.1.1. A boat's series score shall be the total of all her race scores. That is, no races are excluded. This changes Rule A2.

10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 10.1. Unrestricted for One-Design Centerboard and beach multihulls, others only by permission from the Judges/Race Committee.

11. AWARDS

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded for first, second, and third place series finishes in each class or division.
- 11.2. Daily prizes will be awarded following the conclusion of each day's racing

12. DOCKAGE

- 12.1. Dockage is included in the registration fees and will be available only to those who have completed registration for the regatta by the deadline specified herein.
- 12.2. Competitors shall follow the directions of the I-LYA Dock Master. The I-LYA Dock Master and his/her crew, including the person in charge of the drysail area at PIBYC, are part of the Race Committee. Failure to comply with the directions of the I-LYA Dock Master and/or crew shall be grounds for protest and possible expulsion from the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

- 13.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid, third-party insurance sufficient to cover liability for loss, damage, personal injury, or death.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 14.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
