### NOTICE OF RACE

RULES	The Regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
ELIGIBILITY	Open to PHRF competitors with a valid 2018 PHRF-MA certificate. Class and PHRF division splits will be posted prior to 0900 hours on September 8, 2018 on the official notice board on the club deck.
ENTRIES	Eligible boats may enter by completing the official entry process on the Yacht Scoring web site <a href="http://www.yachtscoring.com">http://www.yachtscoring.com</a> and paying all fees, by September 8.
ENTRY FEE	The entry fee is \$75.
INSTRUCTIONS	Sailing Instructions will be available prior 0830 hrs. on September 8 at the regatta desk. A copy of the Sailing Instructions will be available on-line at <a href="http://www.yachtscoring.com">http://www.yachtscoring.com</a> .
SCORING	The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply. Each boat score shall be the total of her race scores.
SCHEDULE	Harbor Gun will be at 1100 hrs. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1200 hrs. The race committee will determine the number of races. It is anticipated to run 2 to 4 races weather dependent.
RACE AREA	Races will be sailed in Raritan Bay. The approximate starting area will be in area of Great Beds Light and West of the area between Keyport "1" and Sequine Point, Staten Island, NY. RYC vessel Raritan Rose will be the Race Committee Boat. The Commodore's Cup starting area may be from the Raritan Rose or a start closer to RYC fleet.
COURSES	PHRF Courses will be windward/leeward, or as described in the Sailing Instructions. The Race Committee will determine the Commodore's Cup course.
PRIZES	Awards will be given for the top three finishers in each class following racing on Saturday.
INSURANCE	Each boat shall hold adequate insurance including third-party liability insurance, and it is the owner or owner's representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event.

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk.
