## Eligibility:

All boats must be over 20 feet LOA. Classes expected include PHRF A, B, C, NS (double headsail allowed), One-Design classes to include Viper 640, J70, J24 and others with 5 of more entries. Also expected are Cruising and Multihull fleets.

PHRF, Cruising and Multihull fleet boats must meet the Nearshore category of the US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (which are posted at the HYC website). All PHRF fleet competitors must have a current, valid PHRF of the Chesapeake rating certificate. Multihull boats must have a current, valid Chesapeake Multihull Association rating.

One Design classes and Multihull Division boats must have at least five (5) entered and paid by May 16<sup>th</sup>.

#### Races:

Racing for PHRF, One Design, Cruising and Multihull Divisions:

PHRF DIVISION: Racing FRIDAY and SUNDAY will be windward/leeward courses in the harbor.

- Offset marks and gates
- Non-Spin may use double-headsails
- Goal = a 6 race series (3-1-2)

SATURDAY will be a Distance Race in the Bay starting off Buckroe and finishing at Fort Monroe.

- Unique course with multiple options to shorten
- Finish at Fort Monroe seawall
- PHRF Random Course ratings will be used

ONE DESIGN DIVISION: All racing will be windward/leeward courses in the harbor.

- Offset marks and gates
- Short courses with multiple races run each day
- Five (5) boats required for a separate class start.
   OD Class must be "made" (entered and paid) by May 16<sup>th</sup>

CRUISING & MULTIHULL DIVISIONS: Race Saturday and Sunday only with special low entry fee.

- Saturday = Distance Race in the Bay
- Sunday = Random Leg race in the harbor with own Race Committee
- No windward/leeward courses. All courses with off-wind legs.

All racing begins at 10:00am each day.

The Low Point Scoring System will be used; 1 throw-out if at least 5 races completed.
