EVENT SAILING INSTRUCTIONS SUPPLEMENT

1 RULES

- 1.2 The sailing instructions (SIs) consist of the 2019 AYC STANDARD DROP MARKS SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (available at <https://annapolisyc.com/racing/raceoffice>) and this Event Sailing Instructions Supplement (called 'the supplement').
- 1.3 If a rule in the supplement has the same number as a rule of the 2019 AYC STANDARD DROP MARKS SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, then the rule in the supplement replaces the rule of the 2019 AYC STANDARD DROP MARKS SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.3 On the water, the race committee will monitor and communicate with boats on VHF channel 72.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 (a) For Harbor 20 and Alerion 28 classes: The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1100. A total of 3 races are scheduled.
(b) For J/70 class: The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1400. Multiple short races will be run.
- 5.4 No warning signal will be made after 1630.
- 5.5 After racing, all competitors are invited to a post-race party and awards presentation on the 2nd deck of the AYC Clubhouse with complimentary beer and cash bar.

6 CLASS FLAGS

- 6.1 The class flags are:

9 MARKS

- 9.1 The starting/finishing mark will be a short yellow cylinder. Marks 1, 2, 3s/3p will be short orange cylinders. Mark 1a will be a short yellow cylinder. When a new mark is used in accordance with SI 12, it will be a short orange cylinder with a black band.

10 START

- 10.5 For Harbor 20 and Alerion 28 classes: Races will be started using RRS 26. For the J/70 class: Races will be started using RRS/US Appendix U except that Flag X will be used.

13 THE FINISH

- 13.1 The finishing line will be between a staff or halyard displaying an orange flag on the race committee finishing vessel and the course side of the finishing mark.
- 13.2 For downwind finishes, the finishing line will be on the *same* side of the race committee vessel as the starting line.

15 TIME LIMITS

- 15.1 The time limits for each class are (in minutes):
