RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the regulations of the Caribbean Sailing Association (CSA), the CSA Minimum Safety Requirements, the Virgin Islands Sailing Association (VISA), and IC-24 class rules, except as any of those are changed by the sailing instructions. The Regatta is designated Category C.

Minimum class size is 4 registered boats. The organizing authority reserves the right to combine, cancel, subdivide, create, or rearrange classes.

ENTRY

Eligible entrants are encouraged to complete the St. Croix Yacht Club (SCYC) entry registration form and submit by mail, fax, or online at www.stcroixyc.com. **The entry fee is \$100.** Payment is due at Registration check in no later than 1800, November 8, 2012. Eligibility requirement for boats is a current CSA rating, except for Multihulls and one design classes.

The Low Point Scoring system, Appendix A, will apply. There may be as many as twelve races, of which two shall be completed to constitute a series.

First place prizes for each class will be awarded on Friday, 9 November and Saturday, 10 November at 1700 and on Sunday, 11 November at 1500.

Series Prizes will be awarded to the first three places in each class in the Regatta tent. **The skipper's weight in rum will be awarded for each class with 7 or more entries.**
