**AMENDMENT #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**The course for Friday, August 10 is changed by moving the starting area to the vicinity of Newcomb Ledge G “1” WHISTLE buoy. This is approximately 12 NM in the direction of Boston. Please note that the Race Committee is still planning to start at the early start time.**

**Friday, August 10**

***Rockport to Boston***

**SQUADRON RUN #5 for the U.S. NAVY CHALLENGE CUPS**

**Rendezvous in the vicinity of G “1” Fl G 4s WHISTLE ( $42^{\circ} 30.461' N, 070^{\circ} 44.395' W$ ) approx. 4 NM due east of Marblehead.**

0955 Attention signal and Special Mark “V” details (if used)

1000 Warning Signal for the first class to start (**EARLY start time**)

**Course - approx. 17.8 NM**

- Start
- Special Mark ‘V’ if used (see SI 9.4)
- Leave R “2” QR Bell at Finns Ledge within 100 yards to port ( $42^{\circ} 22.170' N, 070^{\circ} 55.149' W$ )
- Leave R “4” QR Bell west of President Roads within 100 yards to port ( $42^{\circ} 20.068' N, 070^{\circ} 59.458' W$ )
- Finish at G “13” Fl G 4 sec Boston Main Channel off Pier 6 to starboard ( $42^{\circ} 21.187' N, 071^{\circ} 02.120' W$ )

NOTE: The Race Committee may shorten the course to finish at either R “2” or R “4” depending on Harbor traffic and wind conditions. However, the distance requirement of passing within 100 yards of R “2” and R “4” is not subject to protest by a yacht in accordance with SI 17.3.
