Amendment 1 to the Sailing Instructions

- 10.3 After having started, a boat shall not cross the start/finish line in either direction except when finishing. IRC1, IRC 2 and FS3 and FS4 boats may not pass between Mark 1a and Offset a, at any time.
- 11.2 New marks, as provided in instruction 15.1 will be yellow or orange tetrahedrons encircled by a black band on Alpha Course and will be yellow or orange tetrahedrons with a green top on Bravo Course.
- 12.3 The starting order will be as follows:

Course A: Alpha Course Only Windward-Leeward Course with Gate ALL CLASSES EXCEPT IRC 1, IRC 2, FS 4 and FS 3

Start –
$$1b$$
 – offset b – $2s/2p$ – $1b$ – offset b – $\frac{2s}{2p}$ – Finish

NOTE: Leeward marks are a gate. Pass between the marks, and keep 2p to port, or 2s to starboard. Marks 2s and 2p are not marks of the course on the first leg or the finishing leg.

IRC 1, IRC 2, FS 4 and FS 3 boats are not to pass between Mark 1a and offset a at any time.
