# Sailing Instruction – Distance Race Addendum

AMENDMENT #1 - see additions in RED & strikethrough (deleted)

#### 7. COURSES AND MARK DESCRIPTIONS

If Signal Flag "D" is flown from the RC Signal Boat, the SI Addendum will be used and one long distance race will be sailed that day. The order of class starts will be changed may be reversed and the interval between the class starts may vary.

#### **ADD 7.5 Distance Race Courses**

When Signal Flag "D" is flown from the RC Signal Boat, a long distance race will be sailed. The course will be hailed verbally over the VHF channel for that fleet.

The following marks may be used and additional marks may be hailed if conditions warrant.

A	Orange Tetrahedron	To windward of starting line
В	R "2"	Red flasher -south of Hens & Chickens
C	C"1" dropped mark	Green can off Delancy Point Mid-sound mark approximately 6 miles from mark "A"
D	R "42"	Red bell – off Mamaroneck Harbor
E	N "40A"	Red nun – off Scotch Caps
F	R "40" N "46A"	Red flasher Porgy Shoal 5'MLW ROCK nearby Red Nun at Throgs Neck Bridge
G	R "38"	Red bell – Transport Rock
H	R "36"	Red bell – Bluefish Shoal
I	R "32A" G "29"	Red bell mid sound between Stamford and Oyster Bay Green Flasher - Hewlett Point
J	C "19"	Green can - Oak Neck Point
K	G "21"	Green gong - off Matinecock Point
L	C "1"	Green can – off Weeks Point
M	R "6"	Red bell – off Mott Point (inside Hempstead Harbor)
N	N "4"	Red nun – east of Prospect Point
0	G "23"	Green gong – off Prospect Point
P	Y "A"	Yellow - Execution Rocks Weather Buoy
R	C "1"	Green Can – one mile North of Execution Rocks
S	G "27"	Green gong at Gangway Rocks
T	C "3"	Green Can inside Plum Point - off John Thomson's house
U	Orange Tetrahedron	To leeward of finish line
V	Y "FlY 6S"	Yellow - Western LIS Weather Buoy

## 10. TIME LIMIT

The time limit for the first boat in any class will be four and a half (4 1/2) hours for the distance race. Boats failing to finish within the class time limit, within 60 minutes after the first boat in that class finishes or within the time of the first class finisher plus their time allowance, if applicable, whichever is later, will be scored "Did Not Finish." This changes RRS 35.
