1. RULES

- 1.1 This Regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, Melges 32 Class Association Rules, The J/70 Class Association Rules and the J/105 Class Association Rules, and T Ten Class Association Class Rules.
- 1.2 Class Rules for T Ten regarding weigh-in shall be amended to allow boats to disclose crew weight in writing at registration on site. Weights may be checked during the Regatta to insure compliance. [DP]
- 1.3. Only the US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60.3, 61.4, 67, 70.5(a), 76.1, and 82 will apply.
- 1.4. The Sailing Instructions ("SI's") may contain changes to other rules.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Advertising shall only be displayed in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 2.2. Boats are required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority (OA), in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20. If provided, flags, stickers and decals shall be displayed from the close of check-in through the end of the regatta.

3. ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to Melges 32, J/70, T Ten and J/105 Class boats with a valid measurement certificate on file with the Class Office and five boats registered before August 30, 2019.

4. REGISTRATION AND FEES

- 4.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and paying the required fees. Registration can be found at www.yachtscoring.com.
- 4.2 Competitors shall check in at the regatta registration table (see schedule below) and sign a waiver form and weigh in/complete weight declaration form to complete registration. [DP]

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and at YachtScoring.com in advance.

7. VENUE

Racing will take place on the open waters of Lake Erie, North of Edgewater Yacht Club.

Awards and Sail-gate party following racing.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 The scoring system will be in accordance with the RRS Appendix A.
- 8.2 When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS App. A 2.1.
- 8.3 One race is required to constitute a series.

9. GUEST DOCKAGE AND LAUNCHING

Free dockage and trailer storage from Thursday Sept 19 until Monday Sept 23. Included. (J/70 NAC competitors will receive free dockage & Trailer storage for the duration of both events.) Additional storage can be arranged (may include a fee) by prior authorization from the EWYC Fleet Captain. Launch and haul out travel lift service will be available free of charge for, T Ten and J/105's arriving on trailers. Owners requiring the travel lift must call the Club Office (216-281-6470) in advance to make arrangements. Melges 32, and J/70 may use one of three self-service 2 ton hoists. [DP]

10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 10.1 Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission from the Protest Committee. [DP]
- 10.2 Boats shall be afloat by 0900 on Saturday and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee. [DP]

11. Prizes

Awards will be given to the first three places in each fleet. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

12. PARKING & CAMPING

12.1 Edgewater Yacht Club is a small footprint urban yacht club. Parking space is at premium. Non-members' cars are not allowed to park in the club lot. Competitors may park in designated areas less than 100 yards away in the adjacent Edgewater Lakefront Metropark. Camping is not allowed in the Lakefront Metroparks, or on yacht club property. To accommodate competitors who wish to stay on site, vehicles will be allowed inside the Edgewater Yacht Club gate after 8:00 pm each night. Vehicles must be moved out of the EYC parking lot before 8:00 am each day. Competitors violating 12.1 may not be protested by another boat. [DP] 12.2 EYC bathrooms will be available 24 hours per day to non-members.
