The Organizing Authority is the St. Petersburg Yacht Club, St. Petersburg, FL

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed as defined by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 In accordance with the WFPHRF Rules, this shall be a Race Category 4 event.
- 1.3 This regatta is an Official Suncoast Boat of the Year Event and the St. Petersburg Yacht Club Ocean Racing Challenge.
- 1.4 As allowed by RRS 88.2, the US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2, & 63.4 do not apply to these classes.

2 Advertising

- 2.1 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. Advertising shall be restricted to World Sailing Advertising Code 20.2.2, 20.2.3.

3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Classes will be Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Racer/Cruiser, Cruiser, One Design, and Irwin Class. All Classes must hold current WFPHRF certificates with -100 to 320. See www.westfloridaphrf.org
- 3.2 There must be a minimum of 4 boats per class either one design or PHRF. Any class with less than four will be placed in the appropriate WFPHRF division.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter in advance by completing the Entry Form. See www.spyc.org The Entry Form, a current copy of the WFPHRF Certificate, and a check made payable to "SPYC/Fall Bay Race" should be mailed to the St. Petersburg Yacht Club, 11 Central Avenue, St. Petersburg, Florida 33701. If boats elect to enter electronically using a credit card, a copy of the WFPHRF Certificate must be e-mailed to epennin09@earthlink.net
- 3.4 Deadline for entries is **1700 WED October 9, 2019**. Entries after 1700 Wednesday, October 9, 2019 **MAY BE** accepted solely at the discretion of the Organizing Authority with an explanation of why and will pay an additional (non-refundable) late fee of **\$200.00**.
- 3.5 Skippers in Cruiser Class must declare their intent to use an asymmetrical spinnaker or a cruising chute no later than 1700, Thursday, October 10, 2019.

4 Fees

- 4.1 USSA Member Entry received with copy of card and paid prior to 1700 September 26, 2019 – \$60.00 (Tax included)
- 4.2 Non USSA Members Entry received and paid prior to 1700 September 26, 2019 – \$65.00 (Tax included)
- 4.3 All Entries received and paid after 1700 September 26, 2019 until 1700 October 9, 2019 - \$95.00 (Tax included). **NO REDUCTION FOR USSA MEMBERS ON LATE ENTRY.**
- 4.4 Entry fee includes two admissions to the Saturday PM Cook-Out
- 4.5 Boats that entered and withdraw in writing prior to **Wednesday, October 9, 2019** will receive a refund of their entry fee less an Administrative fee of \$25.00

5 Schedule

- 5.1 Registration: Friday, October 11, 2019 from 1700 to 1900 followed by the Skipper's Meeting at 1900.
- 5.2 Race Schedule: The Race Committee will attempt to have three (3) or more races on Saturday, October 12, 2019 for the Spinnaker Classes including One-Design. All Other Classes will have 1 race. One Race shall constitute a regatta.
- 5.3 First Warning will be @ 1100 Saturday, October 12, 2019

5.4 October 12, 2019-Complimentary Beer, Cookout and Awards Ceremony will be held as soon as practical after racing activities. See Additional Info for details.

6 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available on Friday, October 11, 2019 at the registration desk. Preliminary SI's may be available on the website. www.spyc.org

7 Venue

- 7.1 Landside activities will be at the St Petersburg Yacht Club, 11 Central Avenue, St. Petersburg, Florida.

7.2 The location of the race area will be in Tampa Bay.

8 Courses

8.1 Spinnaker Classes will do a Windward/Leeward course.

8.2 All other classes will do a Random Leg Scoring (RLC) Government Marks Course.

8.3 The courses to be sailed will be contained in the Sailing Instructions.

9 Penalty Systems

9.1 The scoring penalty, RRS Rule 44.3, (a), (b), (c), will apply.

9.2 Competitors must complete the Alternative Penalty Acknowledgement Form and turn it in prior to the end of the 30 minute protest period.

10 Scoring

10.1 The Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except no race will be excluded.

10.2 WFPHRF Buoy Rating will be used for Spinnaker Class and the RLC rating will be used for all other classes.

11 Berthing

Vessels are to berth in the area assigned by the SPYC Harbormaster when arriving for the regatta and returning after the race is completed. Docking arrangements at the St. Petersburg Yacht Club must be made in advance by contacting the Dockmaster at 727-822-3227. Skippers may be allowed to bring their vessels into the marina on the Sunday before the regatta. This will be on a first come, first serve basis. Reservations are a must. Parking - Parking in the SPYC garage is prohibited unless you are a member. Parking is available at the city parking lot south of the club.

12 Radio Communications

Except in the event of an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions. This restriction also applies to cell phones.

13 Awards

Awards will be given as follows. Classes will be divided into divisions according to the number of entries. First, Second and Third place awards will be given for each division in the Fall Bay Race. Other special awards will be given out as deemed by the organizing authority and the Ted Irwin Memorial Organizers.

14 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS 4 "Decision to Race." The organizing authority, the sponsors, the race committee, officers and board of directors of the SPYC, and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.
